

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY CORPORATION OF MALAYSIA (MyIPO) TRADEMARKS ACT 2019 PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 3/2020

THIS PRACTICE DIRECTION is issued in the exercise of the power conferred upon the Registrar of Trademarks by sections 160 and 183 of the Trademarks Act 2019 [Act 815] and in view of the issuance of the Trademarks (Waiver and Modification of Fee) Regulations 2020 which comes into force on 1 January 2021.

PART I

Preliminary

Citation, effective date and scope

- **1.** (1) This practice direction may be cited as the Practice Direction No. 3/2020.
 - (2) This Practice Direction No. 3/2020 shall be effective on 1 January 2021.
 - (3) This Practice Direction No. 3/2020 sets out the requirements to be complied with by any individual, partnership, association, body corporate or institution who is interested to file an application for waiver or modification of fee with the Registrar according to the manner specified by the Registrar in this Practice Direction for any matters specified in the Trademarks (Waiver and Modification of Fee) Regulations 2020.
 - (4) In order to assist with the interpretation of the requirements under this Practice Direction and its application, notes and illustrations have been inserted. The Registrar may take into account any action or conduct which departs from the notes or illustrations in determining the compliance with this Practice Direction as well as the Trademarks Act

- 2019, Trademarks Regulations 2019, Guidelines of Trademarks 2019 and Trademarks (Waiver and Modification of Fee) Regulations 2020.
- (5) By complying to this Practice Direction No. 3/2020, the applicant or registered proprietor of trademark shall be deemed to have fulfilled the requirements of filing the documents with the Registrar in other manner as directed by the Registrar according to paragraphs 30 and 31 of the Guidelines of Trademarks 2019.
- (6) This Practice Direction No. 3/2020 does not replace the availability of filing relevant application through electronic filing system which is made available by the Registrar of Trademarks.

Interpretation

- 2. (1) Unless otherwise defined, all words or terms used in this Practice Direction shall have the meaning as defined in the Trademarks Act 2019, Trademarks Regulations 2019 and Guidelines of Trademarks 2019.
 - (2) In this Practice Direction, unless the context otherwise requires—
 "Practice Direction" means the Practice Direction No. 3/2020;
 "TMRWMF 2020" means the Trademarks (Waiver and Modification of Fee) Regulations 2020;
 "the Counter" means the counter of the Trademarks Office or other branch offices.

PART II

Requirements to be complied

Requirements to be complied by individual, partnership, association, body corporate or institution

3. (1) For the purpose of applying for waiver or modification of fee under regulation 4 or 6 of the TMRWMF 2020, any individual, partnership,

association, body corporate or institution stated in paragraphs 3(1)(a) or (b), or subregulation 5(1) of the TMRWMF 2020 shall—

- (a) file an application for waiver or modification of fee as specified in the First Schedule; and
- (b) comply with all the requirements stated in the TMRWMF 2020.

Notes:

In complying to the requirements under—

- (a) subsubparagraph 4(1)(c)(i)(A) or 6(1)(c)(i)(A) of TMRWMF 2020, the individual may give:
 - (i) a copy of a letter from Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia;
 - (ii) a copy of confirmation SMS from Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia; or
 - (iii) an extract from the bank account proving the receipt of the aid;
- (b) subsubparagraph 4(1)(c)(i)(B) or 6(1)(c)(i)(B) of TMRWMF 2020, the individual may give:
 - (i) a copy of a letter from employer stating that his employment has been terminated; or
 - (ii) a copy of a letter from employer stating that his emoluments or salary has been reduced;
- (c) subsubparagraph 4(1)(c)(ii)(A) or 6(1)(c)(ii)(A) of TMRWMF 2020, the partnership, association, body corporate or institution may give:
 - (i) a copy of a letter from any financial institution confirming an extension of moratorium or repayment flexibility; or

- (ii) a copy of confirmation SMS from any financial institution confirming an extension of moratorium or repayment flexibility;
- (d) subsubparagraph 4(1)(c)(ii)(B) or 6(1)(c)(ii)(B) of TMRWMF 2020, the partnership, association, body corporate or institution may give:
 - (i) a letter from the partnership, association, body corporate or institution declaring that the partnership, association, body corporate or institution is suffering from cash flow problem together with any supporting evidence such as extract of the statement of account;
- (e) subsubparagraph 4(1)(c)(ii)(C) or 6(1)(c)(ii)(C) of TMRWMF 2020, the partnership, association, body corporate or institution may give:
 - (i) a copy of a letter from any vendors or contractors requiring or claiming the partnership, association, body corporate or institution to make payment for any debts owed.
- (2) The forms and supporting document required under paragraphs 3(1)(a) and (b) shall be, either—
 - (a) filed with the Registrar manually at the Counter; or
 - (b) submitted to the Registrar through email at the address of tmwmf@myipo.gov.my,

for the Registrar to issue the decision on the application for waiver or modification of fee.

- (3) All the requirements under the Trademarks Act 2019 shall be applicable on the applicant for registration of trademark or registered proprietor in applying and filling in the model forms TMB4, TME2, TMK1 and TMK3.
- (4) No application for waiver or modification of fee which does not comply with the requirements under this Practice Direction and the TMRWMF 2020 shall be entertained by the Registrar.

Illustrations:

Application for waiver of fee in respect of item 7 or 27 as specified in paragraph 3(1)(a) or (b) of the TMRWMF 2020

ABC Sdn. Bhd., a body corporate, filed an application for amendment of name or address (Model Form TMB4) with the Registrar on 5 January 2021. A week after, the director of ABC Sdn. Bhd. realized that the company could obtain waiver of fee under the TMRWMF 2020. He wishes to get refund for the payment of Model Form TMB4 that he made on 5 January 2021.

In this situation, as the application for waiver of fee is not filed according to the manner required by the Registrar, his application for waiver of fee or refund cannot be entertained. In order to avoid this situation, the director of ABC Sdn. Bhd., on 5 January 2021 should file:

- (a) an application for waiver of fee together with the supporting documents: and
- (b) model form TMB4; and
- (c) file or submit both documents mentioned in (a) and (b) manually at the Counter or through email; and
- (d) fulfill all requirements stipulated under this Practice Direction and the TMRWMF 2020.

Application for modification of fee in respect of item 31 as specified in regulation 5 of the TMRWMF 2020

DEF Sdn. Bhd., a body corporate, has a registration of trademark which is expiring on 2 January 2021. He does not have sufficient fund to pay for the model form TME1 (renewal for registration) by 2 January 2021 as the company is suffering from cash flow problem. On 20 February 2021, the director of the company filed a request for late renewal (Model Form TME2) with the Registrar. A week after, the director of DEF Sdn. Bhd. realized that the company could pay a lesser amount of fee for Model Form TME2 (RM1000) as modified under the TMRWMF 2020. He wishes to get refund for extra payment made (RM200) for Model Form TME2 that he made on 20 February 2021.

In this situation, as the application for modification of fee is not filed according to the manner required by the Registrar, the application for modification of fee or refund cannot be entertained. In order to avoid this situation, the director of DEF Sdn. Bhd., on 20 February 2021 should file:

- (a) an application for waiver of fee together with the supporting documents; and
- (b) model form TME2; and
- (c) file or submit both documents mentioned in (a) and (b) manually at the Counter or through email; and
- (d) fulfill all requirements stipulated under this Practice Direction and the TMRWMF 2020.

Registrar's approval

4. (1) If the forms and supporting document required under paragraph 3(1)(a) and (b) is filed at the Counter according to paragraph 3(2)(a), the Registrar shall issue the decision on the application for waiver or modification of fee on the same day of filing at the Counter.

- (2) If the forms and supporting document required under paragraph 3(1)(a) and (b) is submitted through email according to paragraph 3(2)(b), the Registrar shall issue the decision on the application for waiver or modification of fee—
 - (a) on the same day, if the Registrar received the email together with the completed forms and supporting document from 12.00 am to 4.00 pm on any day from Monday to Friday; or
 - (b) on the next working day, if the Registrar received the email together with the completed forms and supporting document from 4.01 pm to 11.59pm on any day from Monday to Friday or on any excluded days,

by using the Registrar's official email.

Making payment and issuance of receipt for the matter

- 5. (1) If the decision of the Registrar in paragraph 4 is in affirmative, the individual, partnership, association, body corporate or institution shall make the payment required—
 - (a) at the Counter; or
 - (b) through bank or interbank transfer according to the manner stipulated in paragraph 3(1)(d), (e) and (f) of the Practice Direction No.2/2020.
 - (2) For the purpose of applying paragraph 3(1)(f)(i) of the Practice Direction No.2/2020, references to the forms under the repealed Act, or application or request under the Trademarks Act 2019 in relation to the action taken by the applicant or registered proprietor shall be construed as reference to the approval of the application for waiver or modification of fee under paragraph 4 together with its supporting document and the relevant model forms in relation to the matter to be filed by the applicant or registered proprietor.
 - (3) If the payment is made—
 - (a) according to paragraph 5(1)(a), the Registrar shall issue the receipt of payment at the Counter; and

- (b) according to paragraph 5(1)(b), the Registrar shall issue the receipt of payment according to the manner stipulated in paragraph 4 of the Practice Direction No.2/2020.
- (4) The Registrar shall issue a receipt of payment made under this paragraph even though the payment is waived.

Process Flow of Obtaining Waiver or Modification of Fee

6. The process flow of obtaining the waiver or modification of fee is specified in the Second Schedule.



SECOND SCHEDULE

PROCESS FLOW OF OBTAINING WAIVER OR MODIFICATION OF FEE



Applicant/Registered proprietor shall file the documents either at the Counter or submit through email at tmwmf@myipo.gov.my:

- (1) Model form TMB4 / TMK1 and TMK3 / TME2; and
- (2) Application form for waiver or modification of fee ("the form"); and
- (3) Supporting document

Documents incomplete

Documents will be returned to the applicant/registered proprietor

If filed at the Counter, the Assistant Registrar will:

- (1) Check whether the documents are complete and applicant/registered proprietor fulfills all the requirements under the TMRWMF 2020; and
- (2) Acknowledge the form whether the waiver or modification of fee is approved or not

If submitted through email, the Assistant Registrar will:

- (1) Check whether the documents are complete and applicant/registered proprietor fulfills all the requirement under the TMRWMF 2020: and
- (2) Issue an email informing whether the waiver or modification of fee is approved or not
- (1) Upon receipt of approval for waiver or modification of fee, the applicant/registered proprietor will make payment at the Counter or through instant online transfer according to the manner stated in Practice Direction No. 2/2020; and
- (2) If payment is made at the counter of Trademarks Office, receipt of payment will be issued on the same day; or
- (3) If payment is made through instant online transfer, receipt of payment will be issued according to the manner stated in Practice Direction No. 2/2020

Note: Receipt of payment still needs to be obtained by applicant/registered proprietor even though the fee has been waived.

Note:

The applicant or registered proprietor mentioned in this Second Schedule refers to the "individual, partnership, association, body corporate or institution" mentioned in the TMRWMF 2020.
